



## Medication Aide

Foothills Higher Education Center, Room 131

This course is designed to meet the requirements to qualify for work as a Medication Aide. Topics include medication administration via oral routes, medical asepsis, hand hygiene, terminology, and legal implications. Upon completion, students are eligible to take the competency exam and demonstrate skills necessary to qualify for listing on the North Carolina Medication Aide registry. (Required materials provided.)

### Requirements

- CNA I registry in good standing
- Copies of a valid Driver's License and matching Social Security card
- Copy of High School Diploma or GED or sealed transcript of grades

All materials must be turned in to Linda Wright prior to registration. Once copies of all requirements have been received, students may register in person at the Jim A.
