



NURSE AIDE I

Foothills Higher Education Center (FHEC), Room 166

This program provides the opportunity to pursue a healthcare career with entry-level skills in a hospital or nursing home setting. Upon successful completion, the students will be eligible to apply for The Nurse Aide I test administered by NACES. After passing the state test, the student will be listed on the Nurse Aide I registry at DHHS.

Requirements:

- Ninth grade score on the TABE test
- Copies of a valid Driver's License and Social Security card (names must match)
- Copy of High School Diploma or GED or sealed transcript of grades or currently enrolled in the last year of the WPCC Burke Middle College or WPCC AHSD program
- Copy of current CPR Card for the Healthcare Provider from the American Heart Association (must be taken before the first day of class)
