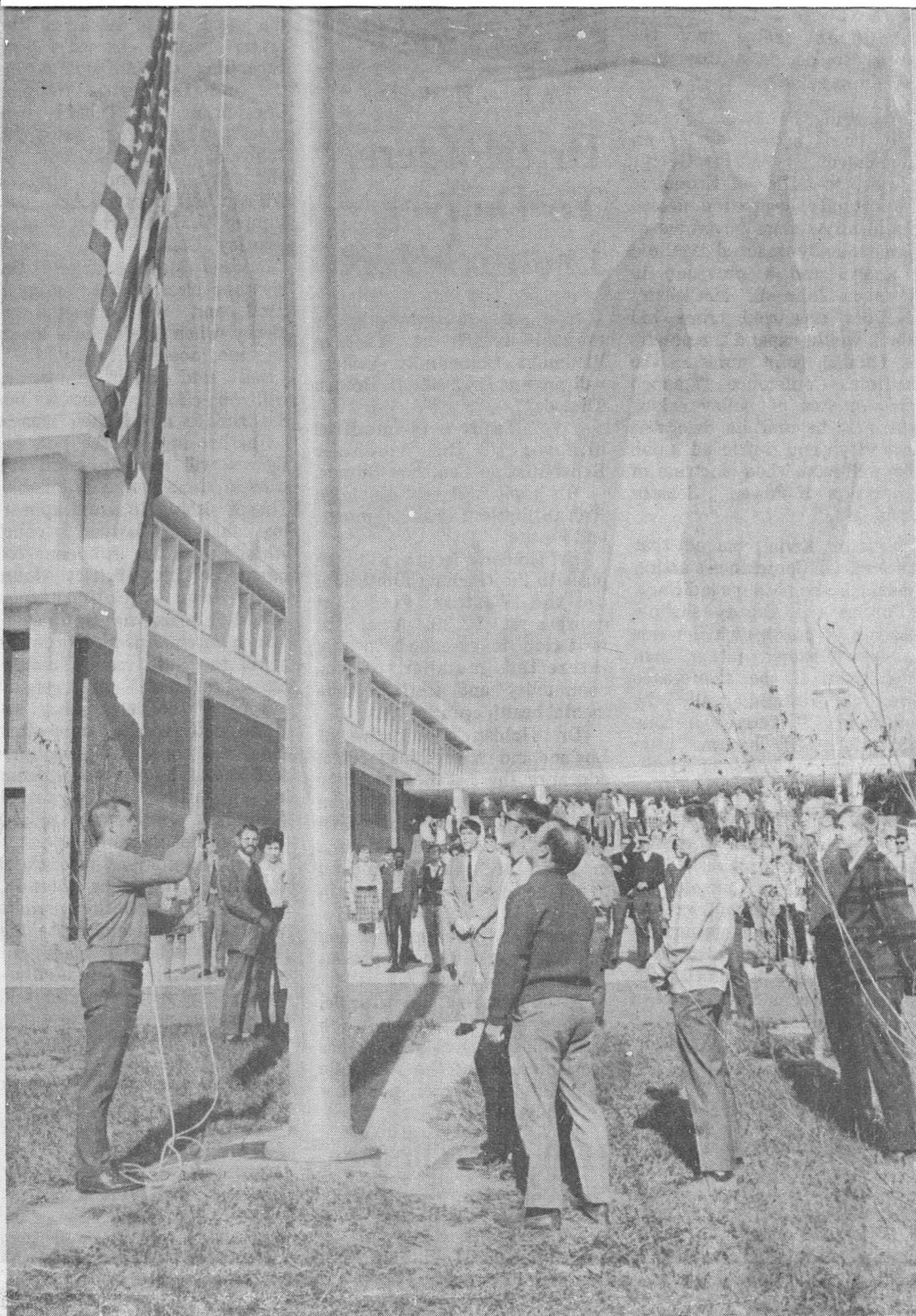




Veterans Raise Flag At WPCC
