

Dr. Phifer Reappointed As Trustee

RALEIGH — Governor Bob Scott today announced the reappointment of Dr. Edward William Phifer Jr. of Morganton to the board of trustees of the Western Piedmont Community College.

Dr. Phifer is a surgeon and writer of local history. He is a former member of the board of education of the Morganton City Schools, a member of the executive board of the North Carolina Department of Archives and history, past director of the Burke County Chamber of Commerce, former vice president of the Morganton-Burke Public Library board, and past president of the Morganton Kiwanis Club. Dr. Phifer and his wife, Mary Adair, have six children.

Dr. Phifer will serve an eight-year term expiring June 30, 1979.

At Western Piedmont it was pointed out today that the reappointment of Dr. Phifer completes the filling of trustee seats for terms expiring this year. Earlier the Board of County Commissioners reappointed Dr. Holman Sigmon and the Burke County Public Schools Board of Education reappointed Robert P. Carr.

Under the staggered term system, each two years the three appointive agencies name one member to the board.
