Hickory Firm Will Design WPCC Unit

Unifour Design, a Hickory architectural firm, has been selected to design the new Continuing Education facilities at Western Piedmont Community College in Morganton.

Dr. Gordon C. Blank, president of the college, said the new facilities will cost an estimated \$100,000.

According to Richard N. Greene, director of Continuing Education at WPCC, said the buildings will be geared to use by special groups in firemanship, law enforcement and other categories of continuing education.

The Hickory firm, headed by Robert L. Clark, a member of the American Institute of Architects, will design a fire tower, a smoke house, burning pits, firing range and a classroom-shop building to be located in the northeast valley section of the WPCC campus.

Designs for the new buildings will be presented within the next several weeks. College officials say the facilities are expected to be operational prior to next summer.
