

Governor names Sitton trustee at WPCC

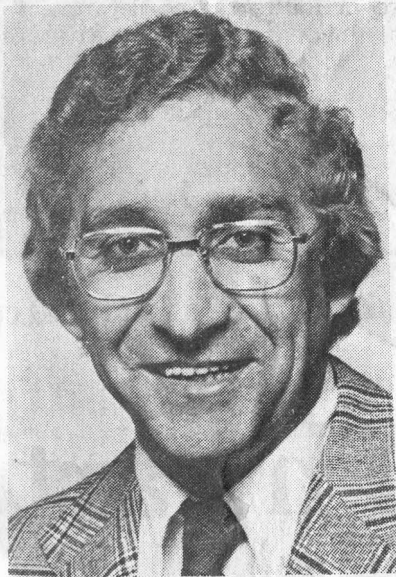
Claude S. Sitton of Morganton has been appointed by Gov. James Hunt to the board of trustees of Western Piedmont Community College.

The announcement of Sitton's appointment was made today.

Sitton replaces William M. Fulton, who resigned from the board. He will be one of 12 members of the board. Four are appointed by the governor, four elected by the county commissioners and four by the local Board of Education. Members serve terms of eight years.

The new board member is a partner with the law firm of Hatcher, Sitton, Powell and Settlemeyer. He is a member and past president of the Morganton Optimist Club and also a member of the Burke County Chamber of Commerce.

Sitton is a member of the First Baptist Church in Morganton where he has recently been elected a deacon. He and his wife, Jo, have two daughters, Julie and Jaye. They live on West Union Street.
