

WPCC selected for program

The Natural Science Department of WPCC has been informed that it was selected as a sponsor of the Albert Einstein Centennial program. Only 12 sponsors received the distinction out of applications from 22 universities, libraries and colleges across the state.

The sponsorship, offered by the N. C. Humanities Committee, includes lectures, a film entitled "Albert Einstein: The Education of a Genius: and a series of 18 free-standing panels which illustrate the highlights of the life of the great 20th century physicist.

Members of the philosophy and the physics departments of the University of N. C. at Greensboro will be featured speakers.

Jack Huss, the Chairman of the Western Piedmont Community College Science Department, hopes to bring the exhibit to the campus for two weeks in the middle of April, 1980. Huss intends to include area science teachers in planning the Einstein Centennial program.
