Communicator added at WPCC

A new member of the Western Piedmont Community College family has been added, and it's a chatty member at that. High on the rolling green hills of the campus is the recently completed sign board which will communicate events going on at the college to students and townspeople.

The sign board project was spearheaded and partially funded by the Student Government Association in response to students' concern about the lack of communication between college and community. Some \$2,000 of funding was allocated from the 1981-82 SGA budget to purchase the

sign. Another \$100 was given by the Phi Theta Kappa honorary society.

The college agreed to lend financial support by paying the cost of installation and bricking. The total cost of the project was \$6,500.
