

Kistler signs proclamation designating WPCC Week

Mayor Andrew M. Kistler II of Morganton recently signed a proclamation designating April 1-7 as Western Piedmont Community College Week.

Chartered by the North Carolina Board of Education April 2, 1964, the college is celebrating 20 years of service as a comprehensive community college.

WPCC is a member of the 58 institu-

tions in the N.C. Community College System and only one of 14 offering college transfer degrees along with technical and vocational programs.

Since the first continuing education classes were offered in 1965, Western Piedmont has conferred more than 3,000 curriculum degrees and diplomas, 3,500 high school diplomas, and 60,000 continuing education certificates.
