The NCLEX for R.N.'s is the licensing examination administered to all graduates of Diploma programs, Associate Degree in Nursing programs and Baccalaureate in Nursing programs. The pass rate for all graduates is about eighty-five percent.

The Associate Degree in Nursing program at Western Piedmont is fully accredited by the North Carolina Board of Nursing and the National League for Nursing. There is a combined enrollment of approximately 100 students in the freshman and sophomore classes.
