WPCC planning trip to Spain

Western Piedmont Community College instructors Ralph Soney and Mary Charlotte Safford will be leading students and members of the community on an 11-day tour of Spain and Morocco on April 4-14.

The trip will begin with a three-night stay in the capital city of Madrid where participants will visit the Prado Museum to view works by Goya and El Greco and tour the Royal Palace. There will also be a day tour to Toledo and El Escorial. The tour will then proceed to the Moorish city of Granada where participants will explore the Alhambra and the Generalife, the summer palace of the Caliphs.

The group will visit Cordoba, the great Moorish cen-

ter of art, philosophy and learning, and the city of Sevilla. A final highlight of the trip will be a day tour of Morocco.

The cost of the trip is \$2,000. This includes airfare, hotel, breakfast and dinner daily and admission for all tours.

Soney, coordinator of the Social Sciences at WPCC, has led educational tours of Russia, Mexico, China and Thailand. Safford, an instructor of history and political science, has led trips to Italy, China, Thailand and Mexico.
