



2024-2025 Scholarships for North Carolina Community Foundation (130+ Scholarships)

At NCCF, we believe in the power of education to improve lives. We partner with donors to administer scholarships for the benefit of students across the state. Nearly 150 college scholarships administered by the North Carolina Community Foundation are open for applications, representing nearly \$1.8 million in available scholarship funds.

This year, NCCF is using a Universal Scholarships Application for the first time. The online application matches information about the student - such as county of residence, GPA or intended major - with criteria for approximately 130 scholarships. Students are then alerted to all scholarships for which they may be eligible.

About [20 other NCCF scholarships have separate applications](#) with different due dates. Students are encouraged to review the criteria for those and follow the instructions on how to apply.

Application Deadline: March 15, 2024

Award Amounts: Varies

Application Requirements: Each scholarship may have differing criteria set by individual donors. However, in general, you will need the following information to complete the Universal Application:

- Demographic data including county of residence, gender, date of birth
- High school information including name of high school and GPA
- Standardized test scores, if taken.
- School/college planned for fall attendance
- Year of study for coming fall semester (freshman, sophomore, junior, senior, other)
- Enrollment status (full-time or part-time)
- Essay and/or supplemental questions (prompt provided in the application form)
- List of extracurricular activities
- Current or most recent transcript (Official high school or Unofficial college transcripts)
- Two letters of recommendation; one from a teacher; and one from a teacher, guidance counselor, coach, pastor, supervisor, or other qualified individual
- Signature by student (or parent/guardian if applicant is under 18)
- Most NCCF scholarships also require the FASFA Student Aid Index/Student Aid Report.
