EPT-4300 NIMS INCIDENT COMMAND SYSTEM ICS-300 (21 hrs.) SECTION #74283

This course provides greater description and details of the Incident Command System (ICS) organization and operations, including the application of essential principles and description of air operations. There are five modules: Organization and Staffing, Organizing for Incidents and Events, Resources Management, Air Operations and Incident, and Event Planning. This course includes a final exam.

EPT-4400 NIMS INCIDENT COMMAND SYSTEM ICS-400 (18 hrs.) SECTION #74287

This course is designed for experienced responders and senior personnel who may be involved in managing major or complex incidents. It builds upon the foundational knowledge gained from ICS 100, 200, and 300 courses. The course focuses on the application of ICS principles in complex scenarios, particularly those requiring Area Command or multi-agency coordination
